Dear Supporters

This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed by everyone in a safe and positive environment.

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

Whether you are a 'home' or 'visiting' supporter we ask you on behalf of our players, club and the league we play in to make each game as safe and enjoyable as possible. In order to help us please observe these guidelines on touchline behaviour:

### **Do's:**

- Do stay one metre back from the touchline. Remain behind either the 'Designated Spectator Area' barriers or the 'Respect' line, painted parallel to the touchline, throughout the game.
- Do cheer, applaud and praise at every opportunity.
- Do make the opponents and their supporters feel welcome.
- Do remember this is amateur youth football.
- Do help to tidy up after the game and please take away any litter.

### **Don'ts:**

- Don't coach individual players from the touchline. Please leave it to the managers and coaches.
- Don't insult, question or threaten the referee, linesmen, managers or coaches.
- Don't take the law into your own hands.
- Don't use bad, foul or abusive language at the games.
- Don't consume alcohol at games.
- Don't criticise the players.

One more time, please remember.....It is amateur youth football and should be enjoyed by everyone involved!!
